The Home

Oxendon House is located in the lovely village of Great Oxendon, just over 2 miles south of Market Harborough. Originally a country house, it retains many beautiful original features, while also having been selectively extended and modernised to offer a high standard of living to all residents. It is set in the privacy of extensive grounds offering views over the surrounding countryside.

Our staff

Oxendon House has an experienced manager who leads a qualified and experienced care team who are on duty 24 hours a day, seven days a week. We continually invest in training our staff to help them develop and gain NVQ qualifications in care. This helps us to continue to improve the care provided to all residents.

We are very proud of the long length of service of many of our staff, which helps us to provide a stable and caring environment for our residents. We also have an experienced and innovative activities coordinator who organises a wide range of social activities to encourage residents to enjoy their stay to the full.

Features of Oxendon House

- Attractive and personal bedrooms
 - 33 beds in total, mainly in single rooms but with twin rooms for residents who prefer companionship
 - The majority of rooms have en-suite facilities
 - 24 hour call facility in all rooms
 - Television point in all bedrooms
 - All furniture and furnishings are provided, but we encourage residents to bring anything they would like with them to help them feel at home
- Two spacious, comfortable residents' lounges and a further dining room
- Refurbished grand staircase
- Pleasant patio area for sitting out on sunny days
- Extensive well maintained gardens to the rear of the property
- Several assisted bathrooms and toilets
- A passenger lift to access the first and second floors
- Ample car parking



Services offered

- Long stay personal care
- Respite care (to give normal carers a break or to try out the Home)
- Day care
- Individual care plans for all residents to ensure their personal needs are met in full
- Well balanced, nutritional menus with fresh fruit, vegetables, meat and home baked cakes; with personal preferences catered for
- Regular and varied activities and social programme, including day trips to attractions and events, exercise classes, games, bands and an annual summer fête
- Television, video and music facilities
- Freedom for visitors to get involved with the Home and contribute to the care and activities
- Personal laundry service

Maintaining high standards

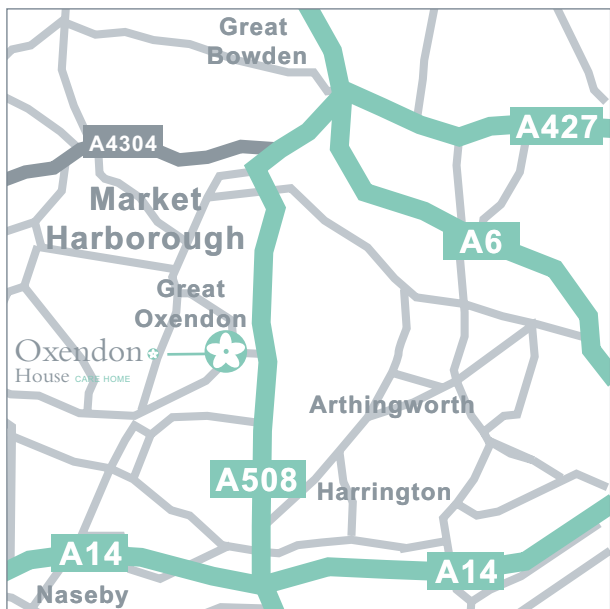
